I. 3:30-3:45 UIP Review: Need to finalize

Discussion:

The focus of the UIP is improving writing. C3 is using interim assessments to set goals in the UIP since C3 does not have TCAP scores. Based on interim assessment scores from last year and the fall of this year, the writing proficiency goal for 2014 is 75% and the 2015 goal is 78%. Given the breadth of the range of proficiency, the goal includes both proficient and advanced scores. Community partners are designed to support academic goals. Review of data will be used to determine the overall effectiveness of the community partner integration. It is important to note that the UIP is a living document and can and will be updated as more data is available.

II. 3:45-4 Review of Projections

Discussion:

The District has preliminarily projected 237 students at C3 for the 14-15 school year. The school is currently serving 191 students in grades K-3. Projections will be finalized by the district in the next few weeks. Projections will drive the budget for next year. If C3 enrolls more students next year, the district will receive additional funds. If C3 does not meet its projected enrollment, it could have to return funds to the District.

The choice process is underway. Results of the choice process will be available in March.
